

TOWN OF HARTLAND SPECIAL MEETING

SEPTEMBER 22, 2008

CALL TO ORDER:

A special town board meeting of the Town of Hartland held on Monday, September 22, 2008 was called to order by the Town Chairman, Robert Woldt at 7 pm in the Town of Hartland town hall.

MEETING NOTICES:

Chairman verified with Clerk that proper postings had been done at the Shawano Leader, Town Hall, corners of N. Highline / Townline Road and S. Highline / E. Slab City Road

ROAD CONSTRUCTION:

This special meeting was held to discuss and make a recommendation on the grinding and subsequent paving of a section of Valley Road between Porter and West Slab City Roads. The town had earlier received an estimate from the county for paving a surface layer only that had been comparatively high because of the compensation for the crown of the road. Grinding the road would eliminate this issue and also ensure that the road would last for substantially longer than just applying a surface layer. Three sections of the road had been marked and the county had noted a project discount of \$5500 if all 3 sections were completed at once. Frank made a motion to approve the grinding and resurfacing of 4,327 feet of Valley Road for a total project cost of an estimated \$77,400. Jay Teschke seconded, motion carried.

Bob had received a driveway permit request from Schmucker with the intent of residential construction just north of the intersection of Valley and West Slab City Roads. According to the survey that accompanied the driveway permit request, there are only 0.93 buildable acres, the rest is a swamp. After lengthy discussion regarding this issue, the potential of flooding this house will be subject too, and the fact that the owner is solely liable for flood damage should it occur, Frank Heller made a motion to approve, seconded by Jay.

Frank stated that Matt Marosek could do the road patching that needs to be done before winter. Jay asked how his prices compared. Discussion followed over the use of hot mixes, etc.

ADJOURNMENT

After no further business was presented, Frank Heller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jay Teschke. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
