CALL TO ORDER:

The monthly town board meeting of the Town of Hartland held on Tuesday, September 7th, 2010 was called to order by the Town Chairman, Robert Woldt at 7 pm in the Town of Hartland town hall.

MEETING NOTICES:

Chairman verified that proper postings had been done at the Shawano Leader, Town Hall, corners of N. Highline / Townline Road and S. Highline / E. Slab City Road

MINUTES:

Clerk read minutes from the August monthly meeting. Jay Teschke made motion to approve minutes and Frank Heller seconded.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Payment of Bills:

Frank Heller made a motion to approve payment of accounts, check numbers 8353-61 totaling

\$13,237.26. Jay Teschke seconded the motion, motion carried.

ZONING

Frank made a motion, seconded by Jay to approve a variance request from Paul Schmidt to expand a current feedpad.

Roy gave short review and discussion on response from Attorney Richard Carlson regarding merging the existing Zoning Committee and Planning Commission into a single entity. This agenda item was tabled until the next monthly meeting.

ROADS

Bob received a complaint about people speeding by the Amish school on Valley Road. Frank made a motion, seconded by Jay, to place reduced speed limit signs of 45mph. This expense, along with brush cutting on Valley, would be cost-shared with Town of Waukechon at 50-50.

Frank stated that Gerald Schmidt had inquired about cutting the roadside ditches again. Motion was made and seconded (Frank/Jay) to approve and also to split township with Matt Marosek again.

Bob stated that WE Energies wants \$38,000 to relocate utility poles on West Townline. Bob proposed leaving the road as is and only grinding & resurfacing versus widening as originally planned. Discussion was held over whether the project would need to be re-bid.

MISC.

Brief discussion was held on renewal of Veolia's contract. Noffke gave a summary on the County's history with Harter's and its predecessor Wittenberg Disposal.

Frank provided minutes from a previous sesquicentennial committee meeting.

Marlin provided an update on the County zoning code revisions. He stated that the town should get a new comprehensive map done as soon as possible.
